During this Forum, we covered quite a broad range of topics, including:

- the European Commission's internal debates and work on the REACH review since the 1 April CII REACH-OSH Forum
- the potential role of the Candidate List in OSH prioritisation
- GRA and professional uses

or better regulation in chemicals management

- RMOAs and ARNs
- the European Commission's thoughts on how to best use substitution
- Germany's views on how to use REACH data for OSH
- the national REACH-OSH frameworks for self-employees
